IMPORTANT: FUNDS AVAILABILITY NOTICE

The following compliance changes are being made to the Funds Availability Policy Disclosure and Deposit Hold Notice, effective July 1, 2025:

- ✓ Funds Availability Policy Disclosure (11452*) The dollar amounts that are included in the Funds Availability Policy Disclosure are being updated to align with the new statutory requirements. Unless a credit union's disclosure already establishes the same or higher thresholds, the dollar amounts are being adjusted as follows:
 - Minimum dollar amount increasing from \$225 to \$275
 - Cash withdrawal amount increasing from \$450 to \$550
 - Exception hold amount increasing from \$5,525 to \$6,725
- ✓ Deposit Hold Notice (D2400*) The dollar amount in the "large deposit" exception hold statement is being increased from \$5,525 to \$6,725.
