

FACTS	What does West Branch Valley Federal Credit Union do with your personal information?	
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all of the sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security Number • Account balances • Payment history • Email addresses • Telephone numbers • Credit history and credit • Transaction or loss history • Account transactions • Internet Protocol (IP) addresses • Operating systems <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>	
How?	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer's personal information; the reasons West Branch Valley Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and where you can limit this sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CUNA Mutual Group

Non-affiliates	Companies do not relate by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>West Branch Valley Federal Credit Union does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you</i>

Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>West Branch Valley Federal Credit Union does not jointly market</i>
